March 9, 2025 - Symphony Concert at 3:00 pm at The Independence School

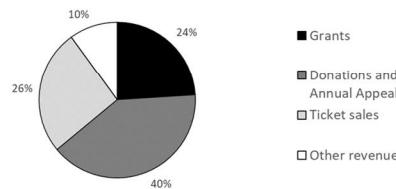
April 6, 2025 - Free Family Concert at 3:00 pm at Newark Charter Performing Arts Center

May 18, 2025 - Symphony Concert 3:00 pm at The Independence School

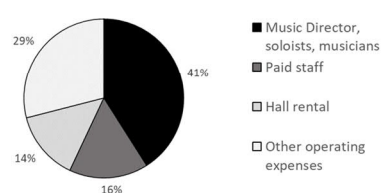
